This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving C or better in English and Mathematics in Years 1 and 2 to 30 % in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of students meeting NAPLAN national minimum standard in Year 3 Reading, Writing and Numeracy to 80% by 2017.
- Ensure that every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is with an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a "C" standard or better against the relevant year level achievement standard.

Our initiatives include

- Provide focused and intensive teaching targeted at Prep and Year 1 students in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning against their year-level achievement standard.
- Build teacher capacity to embed consolidation strategies in English and Mathematics across all year levels.
- Provide education for parents of birth to pre-Prep students to support the development of oral language and early literacy and numeracy skills at home.
- Develop a whole school Mathematics Curriculum plan and school approach to teaching numeracy.
- Partner with other agencies and provide resources and expertise for supporting the Families as First Teachers (FaFT) program.
- Use Early Start materials across Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track student progress.
